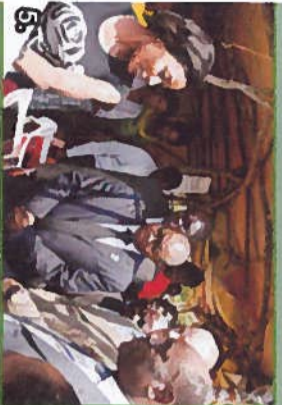
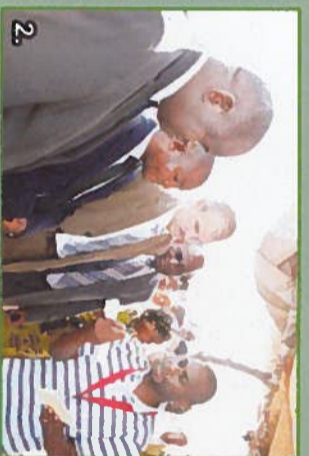




**PICTORIAL FOCUS ON CHILD LABOUR ELIMINATION ACTIONS
